Rationale and Aims

The international conference Landscape 2021 will bring together scientists from across disciplines with key actors to explore how diversity and diversification in landscapes can contribute to a more sustainable and resilient agriculture. Promising approaches integrate high productivity with minimal use of external resources, the provisioning of ecosystem services and protection of biodiversity. Both adaptable and flexible under climate change and market shocks, they support rural communities with robust economic perspectives, employment and recreational opportunities. Conference contributions will include research from natural and social sciences, including inter- and transdisciplinary approaches on topics related to the diversification of cropping systems (crop rotations, cropping patterns), farm activities (arable, livestock, agroforestry, bioenergy), landscape patterns as well as governance and institutional arrangements.
